NXPLORERS AWARD Outstanding NXplorers student team

This award is to recognise outstanding NXplorers student teams who are an inspiring example of how young people can work together to solve real problems

What are we look for in an Outstanding NXplorers student team?

- **Teamwork:** All team members are involved and well engaged. All team members contributed and brought their different perspectives to the team.
- **Engagement**: Students engage and connect to the issue and show interest to learn more about their issue and incorporate their learning into how they might address it
- Ability to bring about change: The team has a developed a meaningful action plan and identified creative ways to engage with their community and to bring about positive change
- A new way of thinking: Change project demonstrates relevant application of NXthinking.
- **Project delivery**: Change project is being worked on or has been completed. The team has used the learnings to improve the project and share with others.

NXPLORERS AWARD

Exceptional NXplorers project by a student team

This award recognises NXplorers teams that have delivered exceptional NXplorers change projects with potential for impact on their community and society.

What are we look for in a NXplorers project by a student team?

- **Problem statement:** The issue chosen by the students addresses a complex problem and they are able to articulate the challenge and how it might relate to a real-world problem
- **A new way of thinking**: Change project demonstrates relevant application of NXthinking.
- **Project delivery:** The change project has been developed and has potential for impact on community and society. The team has used the learnings to improve the project and share with others.
- **Innovation**: The approach is interesting/unusual and could work very well.
- **Teamwork**: All team members are involved and well engaged. All team members contributed and brought their different perspectives to the team.

Special recognition Award Excellence in Facilitation

This award is to recognise excellence in the facilitators and teacher who are a role-model for their students and enable them to embrace complexity and overcome barriers

What are we looking for in Excellence in Facilitation in a (partner) facilitator or teacher?

- **NXplorers tools and methodology:** Demonstrated excellence in their deep understanding of NXplorers methodology and NXthinking. Use of relevant real-world examples forms part of their delivery and they adapt to the participants' stage of development
- **Strong facilitation skills:** Participants are consistently and actively engaged. Participants are comfortable in asking and answering questions in front of the wider group.
- **Inspiring teacher:** Use coaching skills to encourage shifts in thoughts and perspectives in young people in a way that they feel engaged and motivated to take positive action.
- **Disposition**: Confident, Flexible, Disciplined. Willingness to learn alongside participants
- **Leadership**: Going beyond the call of duty to ensure that students are supported in all circumstances.

Special recognition Award Inspiring NXplorers Mentor

Recognises the inspiring (Shell) mentors who go the extra mile to enthuse and empower the young people they support on their NXplorers journey

What are we looking for in an Inspiring NXplorers Mentor?

- **Coaching**: Good coaching and listening skills
- Agency: Gives the students agency to own their project and come up with solutions to challenges
- Inspire: Supporting and motiving students to embrace complexities and take on real world challenges
- **Support:** Encourage students by sharing their experience and knowledge and guiding them to the right resources
- Building trust: Having two-way conversation, being positive and encouraging
- **Commitment:** Being dedicated and available to support students in a flexible and responsive manner
